# JUDGE FROLLO'S OBJECTIVE

**Start your turn with two Gypsies and Esmerelda captured while Quasimodo is under your control.**

Judge Frollo has a very straightforward, yet sometimes tricky objective to reach. He must search through his own Fate deck, find the Gypsies as well as Esmerelda, and capture them all, all while maintaining his influence over Quasimodo.



## SPECIAL SETUP

Place a Lock Token on the Court of Miracles at the beginning of the game. Frollo must find a way into the Court first.

# FINDING GYPSIES

Frollo must go on a hunt to find Gypsy Heroes to capture. Use the effects of Chessmaster and I Want Her Alive to search through your Fate deck and find the Gypsies.

Being targeted by Fate actions can be helpful as well, but certain Heroes can pose huge threats. Make sure to discard Clopin and the Archdeacon whenever you can.



## I WANT HER ALIVE

Reveal the top three cards of your Fate deck. You may choose to play one. Discard the rest.



## CLOPIN

All Gypsies in Frollo's Realm gain 1 Strength.

# OPENING THE COURT

Opening the Court of Miracles, unlike many locked locations, is not strictly necessary to win. However, many of the actions available are very helpful.

You can unlock the Court of Miracles by playing Attack at Dawn. Note that if Quasimodo is under your control at the time, he will swap loyalties.



## ATTACK AT DAWN

Find Quasimodo and play him to the Court of Miracles, even if the location is locked. Then, unlock Court of Miracles.

# THE CAPTURE MECHANIC

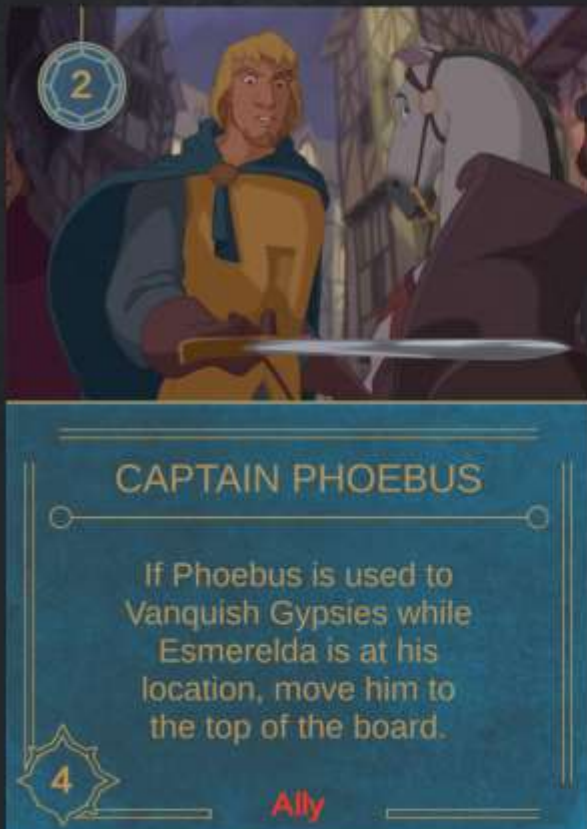
Judge Frolo doesn't always want to kill his enemies outright. Sometimes he wants to keep them around for interrogation and the like.

When Frolo defeats a Hero, he may choose either to discard them or add them to his Captured pile.



While a Hero is there, its effect still takes place, so capturing Clopin or the Archdeacon isn't always a good idea.

# CAPTAIN PHOEBUS



Captain Phoebus is the most reliable way to defeat Heroes, as he is the only Ally in the deck with enough Strength to take down Gypsies on his own. Bear in mind, though, that he will betray you if Esmerelda sees him, and there's no way to earn Phoebus' loyalty back.

# DEFEATING GYPSIES

Frollo has several useful tools for defeating any Gypsies he needs to.

Edict of Purity is a very powerful card that lets you defeat any Hero at your location--potentially letting you defeat multiple Heroes in one turn!



Paris Guards, in combination with Symbol of Authority, can mow through crowds of Gypsies through Vanquishing. Note that you'll need multiple Guards for this to work.



If you're having trouble finding your cards, try Penance. It will help you get the cards you need, and throw away cards you don't.



# QUASIMODO

Quasimodo is prone to swap sides often, either due to Esmerelda meeting him, escaping to join the Feast of Fools, or even taking a chance and going Out There.



You will have to find ways of forcing him back to your side regularly, so keep those in mind.

## ESCAPING TARGETS

Esmerelda and Justice! are both cards capable of setting captured Gypsies free. Be wary of them, discard Justice! with Chessmaster whenever you can, and don't let Esmerelda move around on her own too much. It's tricky to recapture escaped Gypsies.
